THE ADDITION OF 21-3-1 "HOURS," BY THE ADDITION OF SECTION 21-3-1
"HOURS" OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF
TAYLOR SPRINGS**

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and that protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Village is an Illinois Municipality in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970;

WHEREAS, the Illinois Liquor Control Act of 1934 235 ILCS 5/1 et seq. empowers and authorizes the Village to adopt rules, regulations and restrictions to oversee and control the issuance of Village liquor licenses and operations thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Village is desirous of adopting such rules regulations and restrictions, and incorporating ordinances into the Revised Code of Ordinances of the Village of Taylor Springs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT
AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF TAYLOR
SPRINGS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**ORDINANCE NO. 14-534 IS HEREBY REPEALED AND REPLACED with
the following:**

**CHAPTER 21 ARTICLE 3 SECTION 1 (21-3-1)
HOURS**

21-3-1 HOURS. It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale at retail, any alcoholic liquor in the Village as follows:

(A) "Class A" license shall not sell alcoholic liquor during the following hours:

Sunday	1:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
Monday	12:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
Tuesday	12:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
Wednesday	12:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
Thursday	12:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
Friday	12:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
Saturday	1:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.

Fifteen (15) minutes after the time that a Class "A" license is not allowed to sell alcoholic liquor, all patrons must have vacated the tavern.

Thirty (30) minutes after the time that a Class "A" license is not allowed to sell alcoholic liquor, all patrons must have vacated the tavern's parking lot.

(B) Class "B", "C", and "D" licenses shall be closed during the following hours:

Sunday	1:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
Monday	12:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
Tuesday	12:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
Wednesday	12:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
Thursday	12:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
Friday	12:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
Saturday	1:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.

(C) The exceptions to paragraph (A) are as follows:

- (1) On the Fourth of July, Class "A" license shall not sell alcoholic liquor from 2:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
- (2) On Thanksgiving, "Class "A" license shall not sell alcoholic liquor from 2:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
- (3) On Labor Day, "Class "A" license shall not sell alcoholic liquor from 2:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
- (4) On Memorial Day, "Class "A" license shall not sell alcoholic liquor from 2:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
- (5) On the Thursday of Old Settler's Day and Friday after Old Settler's Day, "Class "A" license shall not sell alcoholic liquor from 2:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
- (6) On the day of the \$10,000 Dance, "Class "A" license shall not sell alcoholic liquor from 2:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
- (7) On the day of Stamp-Out Cancer, "Class "A" license shall not sell alcoholic liquor from 2:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.
- (8) On two floating days with prior approval by the Village Board of Trustees or their designee, "Class "A" license shall not sell alcoholic liquor from 2:45 A.M. to 7:00 A.M.

Fifteen (15) minutes after the time that a Class "A" license is not allowed to sell alcoholic liquor, all patrons must have vacated the tavern.

Thirty (30) minutes after the time that a Class "A" license is not allowed to sell alcoholic liquor, all patrons must have vacated the tavern's parking lot.

(D) A license holder convicted of violation of paragraph (C) of this Section, shall be closed pursuant to paragraph (A) only of this Section and paragraph (C) of this Section shall not apply to the license holder convicted of violation of paragraph (C) of this Section.

(E) **Violation of the Ordinance.** If the license holder violates this Section, the Village may seek a fine of not less than **Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00)** or more than **Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00)** for any one offense. The first violation of this Section shall be a fine in the amount of **Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00)**. Subsequent violations of this Section by the license holder shall be increased by

increments of **One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)** per offense up to the maximum fine of **Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00)** per offense.

Any contested municipal ticket shall be filed with the Montgomery County Circuit Clerk and prosecuted through the Fourth Judicial Circuit located in Hillsboro, Montgomery County, Illinois. The Village may in addition to seeking the fine above, may seek an award of court costs and attorney fees against the person so convicted of violating the abovementioned ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication as required by law.
